

## Community Grant Program 2022 RD1 Recipients

Applicant	Project Snapshot
Sydney Children's Hospitals Foundation	To purchase a portable infant manikin for ongoing training for the Newborn & Pædiatric Emergency Transport Service medical staff, enabling them to engage in scenario-based training to develop neonatal advanced life support skills.
The Exodus Foundation, Ashfield	To upgrade the Foundation's community dental clinic allowing Sydney's most vulnerable to access free oral health treatment.
Balmain Para-Rowing Program Incorporated	To purchase a complete set of sweep oars to enable a donated 'Eight' to be rowed by para-rowers of the Balmain Para-rowing Program.
Gardeners Road Public School P&C Association	To purchase STEM learning equipment including Techbar, stools and storage to create an inclusive 'MakerSpace' within the library.
St Mary & St Mina's Coptic Orthodox College, Bexley	To create an outdoor learning space for students including painting, seating, landscaping, fencing and security cameras.
Carlton Public School P&C Association	To rejuvenate the school playground including synthetic grass, outdoor play stations and murals.
St George Girls High School P&C Association	To improve the school hall bathroom facilities for both students and various community groups.
Islamic Women's Welfare Organisation	To develop a safe, functional, and inviting outdoor space to hold classes and community events, including a storage shed, and protective pergola.
Explore & Develop Leichhardt	To create a large-scale wall mural painted by an Indigenous artist from Saltwater Dreamtime, visible by the public. The artist to also provide educational lessons about Indigenous culture.
Sydney Bus Museum Limited	To fund the specialised manufacture of original style steel wheels, along with the supply and fitting of new tyres. This will complement the restoration work being completed on the 1927 white historic bus and will enable its display to the public at the Sydney Bus Museum.
Fort Street High School	To establish a free app with a virtual tour of the new Fort Street High School Museum, giving digital access to the significant historical archival collection that celebrates public education in NSW.

Annandale Public School P&C Association	To install a sandstone log amphitheatre, a sandstone reading circle and large format sandstone steppers.
Autism Spectrum Australia (Aspect)	To purchase PM Benchmark and Reading Kits to roll out an evidence-based literacy program for Autistic students at the Marrickville and Leichhardt campuses.
Reverse Garbage, Marrickville	To install a rainwater tank to irrigate a new learning garden and flush toilets. This will be used as a practical demonstration for the sustainability education program.
PCYC Marrickville	To fund the Midjuburi Ballers program, a weekly early morning intervention, resilience and capacity building program targeting Indigenous youth in the inner west area.
New Theatre, Newtown	To install 12 new, thick, woollen flame retardant curtains of varying widths to cover the back of the stage area.
Turbans4Australia	To purchase a ducted air conditioning system for the Community Centre and Community Pantry.
Rainbow Club, Inner West	To develop and deliver a series of swimming lessons using a unique program designed to help children with a disability learn how to swim.
Strathfield South Public	To fund students to access a water safety program.
Gidget Foundation Australia	To increase service provision by one day per week at Gidget House Merrylands, to deliver an increased number of free individual psychological counselling sessions for pre and postal natal women.
West Harbour Rugby Club, Concord	To purchase three supreme strength marquees to provide change rooms and shade for the teams and for spectators at home and away games.
