<p>The Chair:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Opened the meeting with an acknowledgement of country and gave a brief outline of his background before inviting community members to introduce themselves.</li> <li>• Invited any declarations of interest from participants – none were offered.</li> <li>• Noted that minutes from the previous meeting were distributed inter-session and, with no comments received, had been accepted.</li> <li>• Noted that there were no outstanding actions carried over from the previous meeting for consideration.</li> </ul>	None
<b>3.0 Air quality items raised by community members</b>	
<p>The Chair:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Noted and confirmed there were no air quality related items raised by community members for discussion.</li> </ul>	None
<b>4.0 Updates from the project team</b>	
<p>The Chair invited the WestConnex team to provide the meeting with an:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Overview of air quality complaints since last meeting</li> <li>• Update on air quality monitoring stations.</li> <li>• Update on M4-M8 Link.</li> </ul> <p>The WestConnex team provided a presentation, advising:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There had been no air quality complaints since the last AQCCC meeting.</li> <li>• There had been no air quality exceedances recorded since the last AQCCC meeting. Ambient air quality data for each of the four monitoring stations was presented showing that: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ All air quality results were well below the allowable limits established by the project’s air quality monitoring regime;</li> <li>○ There had been no impact to air quality in the period after axial fans were shutdown in Parramatta Road Ventilation Facility (PRVF) and Campbell Road Ventilation Facility (CRVF).</li> </ul> </li> <li>• A replacement axial fan had now been installed in CRVF and a recommissioning process was underway with a full suite of fans expected to be back online over the coming months. Testing is underway on all other fans and variable speed drives to ensure any other potential faults are identified and rectified.</li> </ul> <p>Community representatives noted there had been no issues raised by the community since the last meeting.</p>	None.
