Changed traffic conditions – Princes Highway and Campbell Street, St Peters

Work is underway on WestConnex which involves widening and extending the M4 and M5 and joining them to create a free-flowing motorway network.

As part of the project, the New M5 will duplicate the existing M5 East corridor, doubling vehicle capacity and easing congestion between St Peters and Beverly Hills. It will include twin tunnels, an upgrade of King Georges Road Interchange and a new interchange at St Peters. Visit westconnex.com.au/NewM5 for more information.

To safely undertake property clearing work, changed traffic conditions will be in place from **Tuesday, 3 January 2017 until Wednesday, 1 February 2017**, weather permitting, along:

- **Princes Highway** between Short Street and Albert Street
- **Campbell Street** between Unwins Bridge Road and Barwon Park Road

Traffic changes will include:

- full and partial closures on Campbell Street
- lane closures on Princes Highway
- reduced speed limits
- footpath closures

Traffic control, detour signage and pedestrian management will be in place during the work to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, cyclists and workers.

If you are traveling in the area, please allow extra time and follow the signage and the direction of traffic controllers.
