



### Pymont Bridge Road site - service investigation work

Work is under way at the Pymont Bridge Road site to prepare for tunnelling to start mid-year. Part of this work includes investigating the location, depth and arrangement of an existing water main under Pymont Bridge Road, so that it can be modified to accommodate tunnelling operations.

#### What we're doing

Work to relocate an existing water main will start from **Thursday 21 February** and will take approximately one week to complete, weather permitting. Work will occur during the daytime hours **of 10.00am and 3.00pm Monday to Friday**, when the project has approval to work on the road.

A temporary work area will be established in the eastbound traffic lanes of Pymont Bridge Road where a deep trench, approximately 4 metres long, will be opened in order to access the water main. A map of the work and approved traffic changes is provided over the page.

The work will involve:

- Establishing traffic control and signage as required
- Excavating a deep trench in the ground and installing support structures
- Removing the ground material by using a high-powered vacuum truck
- Measuring, assessing and documenting the location of the water main
- Backfilling and reinstating the ground

**There are no planned impacts to water supply as a result of this work.**

#### How this affects you

This work is likely to generate temporary periods of noise. The Project is committed to minimising construction impacts to surrounding residents and businesses by:

- Consulting with directly affected residents and businesses prior to work commencing
- Observing respite periods during high noise construction activities
- Ensuring plant and machinery are serviced regularly to reduce emissions and turning them off when not in use

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- Scheduling work to occur during daytime hours instead of at night. The work will result in daytime traffic impacts.

### Traffic changes

In order to accommodate this work during the daytime, both eastbound lanes on Pymont Bridge Road will be closed during working hours. As shown below, a contra-flow traffic arrangement will operate in the westbound lanes. On-street parking around the work area as shown below, will be unavailable during the working hours of 10.00am and 3.00pm.





The pedestrian path along Pymont Bridge Road will not be impacted by the work. Access to Chester Street will be maintained at all times.

Signage and traffic control will be in place to direct motorists and pedestrians through these changed traffic conditions.
