

### Mascot

Welcome to the New M5 summer construction update for work occurring in the Mascot area. This edition will provide an update about current construction and upcoming activities over the next three months at the Gardeners Road and Bourke Road intersection. Construction work on Gardeners Road and Bourke Road is well underway. Gardeners Road west of Kent Road is continuing to change dramatically as property removal work progresses. The cleared space shows where the new bridge over Alexandria Canal will land at the end of Gardeners Road, providing motorists coming from Mascot access to the future St Peters Interchange and links to the New M5 and M4-M5 tunnels.

The crew has also been continuing their utility investigation and relocation work along Gardeners Road and Bourke Street/Road. Utilities including power, water, communications and gas are required to be relocated to sit within the new road alignment and upgraded – some electrical cables for example are 80 years old.

In order to do this, night work on Gardeners Road and Bourke Road/ Street has been ongoing. Intermittent night work will continue for the next three months as the crews are limited in the work they can conduct during the daytime due to traffic impacts.

Traffic changes will be in place along Gardeners Road and Bourke Road for the project's duration. Closure of

one eastbound lane along Gardeners Road will continue to be in place until construction is complete in early 2020.

We thank you for your patience as this important upgrade takes place and will keep you updated as work progresses.

### Upcoming activities

A number of activities will be taking place over summer along Gardeners Road and Bourke Road/ Street. These include:

- Continuing construction of the new Venice Street connecting Gardeners Road with Ricketty Street
- Completing property removal on Gardeners Road including units 1 and 2 at 697 Gardeners Road, and the former Beaurepairs building
- Commencing drainage installation work on Gardeners Road west of Kent Road
- Ongoing utility investigation and relocation works along Gardeners Road, Kent Road and Bourke Road/Street
- Commencing road construction and drainage installation within the Bourke Street site.

### Traffic changes

The pedestrian detour along Gardeners Road has been removed and full pedestrian access has been returned.

Changed traffic conditions will continue to be in place, with temporary impacts to pedestrian pathways in the future. Signage will be in place to direct users and access will be maintained.

Please drive carefully through these areas and allow extra time for your journey.
