Traffic Switch (Stage 5) – M4 Motorway, Homebush

From **Sunday 28 January 2018**, work will commence to realign the M4 Motorway westbound between Underwood Road and Homebush Bay Drive, Homebush. A map showing the location of work is provided overleaf.

The newly aligned M4 Motorway westbound, between Underwood Road and Homebush Bay Drive, will be open to traffic from 9.00 am Sunday, 11 February 2018.

Timing and work hours

Work has been scheduled to take place **between 7.00 am and 6.00 pm Monday to Friday and 8.00 am and 1.00 pm on Saturday**. Work requiring road or lane closures will occur between **6.00 pm and 7.00 am Sunday to Saturday**.

This work is expected to take up to **three weeks** to complete, weather permitting.

Work activities include:

- ground excavation
- concrete work with road/concrete saws
- installing drainage
- pavement work, including asphalt mill and re-sheet
- relocation and placement of traffic barriers
- removal of existing line marking and installing new line marking
- installing new traffic signage and street lighting.

Equipment used will include excavators, bobcats, road/concrete saws, jackhammers, pavement profiler, asphalt pavers, compactors, vacuum excavation trucks, cranes, lighting equipment, concrete trucks, semi-trailers, street sweeper and hand tools.

Minimising impact

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this including by using low-tonal reversing beepers on machinery during night work, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noisy equipment away from residences where possible.

Traffic changes

Between Sunday 4 February and Friday 16 February 2018, there will be night time closures on the M4 Motorway westbound between Parramatta Road, Concord and Homebush Bay Drive, Homebush. If you travel along this route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.
