

Utility diversion work – Ashfield and Haberfield

Further to our notification (N0102a) on Friday, 26 August 2016, work to relocate electrical services and to identify services in the Ashfield and Haberfield area continues.

This work will continue from **Thursday, 1 December 2016** and take approximately **three months to complete**. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

To minimise the impact to residents, work has been scheduled to take place between **7.00 am and 6.00 pm Monday to Friday** and **8.00 am and 1.00 pm on Saturday**, where possible.

However, to ensure the safety of workers and motorists, some night work is required. Night work will take place between **9.00 pm and 5.00 am Sunday to Friday**. High noise activities will only be carried out up to three nights per week, but for no more than two consecutive nights at each location. You will receive further notification when night work is required.

Electrical cable installation will continue in the following locations:

- Parramatta Road, Ashfield (between Bland Street and Orpington Street)
- Chandos Street, Loftus Street, Cecil Street and Orpington Street, Ashfield
- Tinana Street, Haberfield.

Work to identify, relocate and install services will include:

- pruning vegetation
- identifying services, excavating and installing cables or pipes
- temporary restoration works, prior to permanent restoration in consultation with Inner West Council.

Equipment used throughout the work will include excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete saws, compactor plate, trucks, hand tools and lighting equipment.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Lane closures will be in place on Parramatta Road in the vicinity of the night work. If you travel along the work route, please allow extra travel time and follow the direction of traffic controllers.

There will be some noise associated with this work, however every effort will be made to minimise the impact of work, including by using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and, where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences. All sites will also be restored to their previous condition.
