Construction update – Concord Road Interchange

Work is underway on WestConnex which involves widening and extending the M4 and M5 and joining them to create a free-flowing motorway network.

The M4 East will extend the existing M4 from Homebush to Haberfield via underground twin tunnels, each 5.5 kilometres in length and among the widest in the southern hemisphere. They will allow for three lanes of traffic in each direction, saving travel time for motorists and taking traffic off local roads. For more information, visit westconnex.com.au/m4east.

In September 2016, surface work commenced to construct the Concord Road Interchange. Work will continue to construct the cut and cover tunnel and tunnel access ramps and portals. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

M4 Motorway and eastern side of Concord Road

Work currently underway and scheduled for the first quarter of 2017 includes:

- establishing construction access underneath Concord Road bridge, including construction of a piled retaining wall
- staged pavement removal and re-construction work
- construction of the westbound on-ramp bridge pier 1 (near the M4), including piling, column and headstock concrete work
- construction of the northern abutment for the new westbound on-ramp bridge (near the western end of Alexandra Street), including the reinforced soil retaining walls supporting the abutment.

Heavy vehicles will access the Concord Road Interchange site via the existing construction site on Concord Road, wherever possible however heavy vehicles are also permitted to access the site from Alexandra Street until the end of January 2017.

Western side of Concord Road

Work currently underway and scheduled for the first quarter of 2017 includes:

- excavation of the cut and cover tunnel on the northern side of Sydney Street, including piling pad construction and piling work
- construction of a piled wall including shotcreting and rock anchoring.

Equipment list

Equipment used will include excavators, bobcats, rock breakers, road/concrete saws, jackhammers, asphalt pavers, compactors, vacuum excavation trucks, piling rigs, drill rigs, cranes, lighting towers, concrete trucks, light vehicles, trucks, semi-trailers, hand tools, chainsaws, and wood chippers.

WestConnex is part of a broader transport plan for Sydney which includes improved public transport, such as Sydney Metro and light rail, as well as better, more reliable motorway solutions. More than two-thirds of WestConnex will be built underground. Once complete, motorists will be able to avoid up to 52 sets of traffic lights and enjoy significant travel time savings.

Hours of work

To ensure minimal impact to nearby residents, the majority of this work will be carried out between **7.00 am and 6.00 pm, Monday to Friday and 8.00 am to 1.00 pm on Saturdays**, weather permitting.

However, some out-of-hours work will be required to reduce impacts on road users and ensure the safety of workers and motorists. You will be provided with further notification of any night work required near your property.

There will be some noise and vibration associated with this work. However every effort will be made to minimise the impact of work, including by using low-tonal reversing beepers on machinery during night works, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, directing noisy equipment away from residences where possible, and undertaking regular noise and vibration monitoring to ensure levels are being managed effectively.

Traffic changes

Night work will require intermittent M4 motorway carriageway or lane closures from Homebush Bay Drive, Homebush to Parramatta Road, Concord between the hours of 10.00 pm and 5.00 am.

Traffic control, detour signage and pedestrian management will be in place during the work to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the work route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and the direction of traffic controllers.


