



Sewer diversion - Carrington Lane and Queen Lane, North Strathfield

Further to notification N213c, from Tuesday, 27 March 2018, work will continue to implement a sewer diversion on Queen Lane and Carrington Lane, North Strathfield. This work is expected to take up to two months to complete, weather permitting. Residents will be notified as work progresses. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

Please note, once operational, the sewer bypass pumps will be required to operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for up to 7 weeks.

What we're doing

The work will involve:

- establishing a sewer diversion -
 - installing sewer bypass plug into manhole
 - commissioning and trialling sewer bypass
 - refuelling of sewer bypass pumps during day shift
 - pumping of sewer through bypass set up.
- excavating along Queen Lane and Carrington Lane to a sewer manhole located at corner of Queen Lane and Carrington Lane
- laying pipe into the sewer pit
- commissioning new sewer line.

Equipment used will include excavators, piling rig, vacuum trucks, concrete saws, core drills, chainsaws, cranes, trucks, compactors, small tools, hand tools and lighting equipment.

How this affects you

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Access to driveways will be maintained. If you travel along the work route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this impact including by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noisy equipment away from residences where possible.

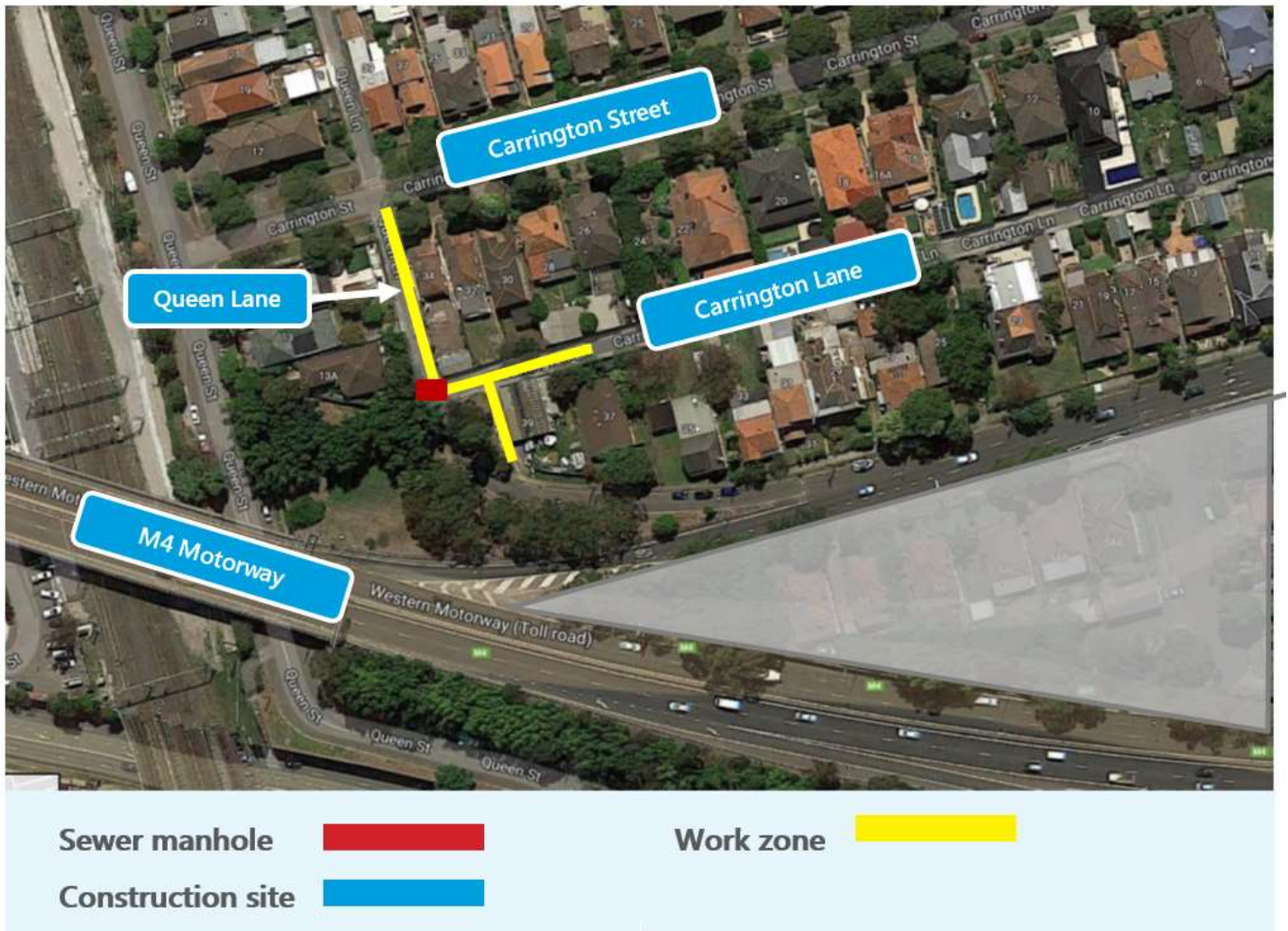
