

Traffic changes – Walker Avenue, Haberfield

From **Friday, 1 September 2017** a traffic change will occur on Walker Avenue to allow heavy vehicles to enter the Wattle Street Site at gate 1 while a sub-station and associated utility services are being constructed for the Parramatta Road Ventilation Facility (PRVF). This change will be in place until early 2018. A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

Both lanes of traffic on Walker Avenue will remain open to the public, with construction traffic only utilising the left turn into Walker Avenue from Parramatta Road. Barriers and hoarding will be placed along the middle of the Walker Avenue to separate the two lanes and provide noise protection for local residents.

To ensure the safety of motorists and pedestrians, traffic control will be in place for heavy vehicle movements on this route.

Timing and work hours

To ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers work to install this traffic change will be undertaken between **7.00 pm and 5.00 am Sunday to Friday**.

Work activities

Work to install the changes will take up to **four shifts to complete**, weather and ground conditions permitting, and will include:

- setting up traffic control
- installing barriers in front of the gate 3 to close the access
- installing concrete barriers and hoarding along Walker Avenue.

Equipment used will include a franna crane, rattle guns, hand tools, light vehicles, and lighting equipment.

Managing impacts

There will be some noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of work, including turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noisy equipment away from residences wherever possible.
