



Sewer main work - Carrington Lane, North Strathfield

From Saturday 9 June 2018, work will continue along Carrington Lane, North Strathfield. This work will facilitate the rectification of the sewer main along Carrington Lane and the reinstatement of Concord Lane.

Access along Carrington Lane and Concord Lane will be closed for the duration of the works. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

The work will involve:

- excavation of Carrington Lane
- connection to new sewer main
- relaying sewer main
- construction of pavement at corner of Carrington Lane and Concord Lane

Equipment used during the work will include excavators, tipper truck, franna crane, generators, concrete pumps, and vibrators, rollers and hand tools

How this affects you

Carrington Lane and Concord Lane will be closed for through traffic as per attached map. Access to driveways will be maintained. If you travel along the work route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this impact including by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noisy equipment away from residences where possible.
