



Night work in Kingsgrove

Night work will be undertaken in sections of the road verge, on the M5 East between Kingsgrove Road and King Georges Road to progress construction of the New M5 project in Kingsgrove.

What we're doing

Work will be carried out over four nights during the existing M5 East maintenance shutdown period from Sunday 15 April to Wednesday 18 April 2018 (weather permitting). These works will be undertaken outside of normal construction hours for the safety of workers and motorists. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

Activities for the April shutdown include:

- North and south cut & cover excavation works
- Line marking & scrubbing
- Survey works
- Temporary barrier installation at King Georges road ramps
- Installation and removal of signage
- Service location works
- Erecting light poles
- Road sweeping
- Relocation of site sheds
- Concrete saw cutting
- Shotcreting

How this affects you

Some of this work will be noisy. Noise monitoring will be conducted for work undertaken outside of standard construction hours.

Any dust generating activities will be watered down to minimise dust.

Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist road users through these changed traffic conditions.
