



## Rescheduled work: Night work and traffic changes at the Campbell Street and Princes Highway intersection from Monday 15 October to Friday 19 October

Night work is scheduled to take place to lay new asphalt at the intersection of Princes Highway and Campbell Street St Peters. Five night work shifts are required to carry out this road surface asphaltting work. Due to the necessary safety and traffic approvals required for lane closures on Princes Highway, asphaltting work at the intersection must take place at night outside of peak traffic volume times.

This work was originally scheduled to begin on Monday 8 October and was postponed due to the wet weather conditions.

### What we're doing

This asphaltting work is being carried out to finalise a section of the new road and footpath along the southern side of Campbell Street, from Crown Street and across Princes Highway to Brown Street.

- Original night work dates: 8pm to 5am on Monday 8 October, Tuesday 9 October and Wednesday 9 October (postponed due to wet weather conditions - no work took place) rescheduled to 8pm to 5am on Monday 15 October, Tuesday 16 October and Wednesday 17 October.

### New rescheduled dates:

- **Night time asphaltting work on Princes Highway on Monday 15 October has been postponed due to forecast wet weather conditions**
- **Night time asphaltting work on Tuesday 16 October and Wednesday 17 October is in doubt and may be postponed**

We will endeavour to complete three (3) night work shifts next week on the Princes Highway southbound lanes near the intersection of Campbell Street and on a section of road on Campbell Street (east). Current night work schedule:

- **Tuesday 16 October, 8pm to 5am**
- **Wednesday 17 October, 8pm to 5am**
- **Thursday 18 October, 8pm to 5am**
- (Friday 19 October, 8pm to 5am, as contingency if the work cannot be carried out on one of the above nights)
- **Asphaltting work will take place on three (3) nights only between Tuesday 16 October and Friday 19 October**

Please note: Monday 22 October and Tuesday 23 October from 8pm to 5am (2 nights) have been tentatively scheduled for asphaltting night work at the Princes Highway northbound lanes near the intersection of Campbell Street pending a review of forecast weather conditions. A notification will be distributed to local residents by Wednesday 17 October to confirm work dates.

### Traffic changes during this night work:

- Two-way traffic maintained on Princes Highway under the direction of traffic control
- Road closure on Campbell Street (east) between Princes Highway and Barwon Park Road; no access between Campbell Street (west) and Campbell Street (east)
- One-way traffic on Campbell Street (east) between Crown Street and Barwon Park Road; left turn only from Crown Street onto Campbell Street (east)
- Access between Victoria Street and Princes Highway maintained
- Parking restrictions will be in place in some areas on Princes Highway between Campbell Street and May Street to facilitate the necessary traffic set up from 7am Monday 15 October

### How night works affect you

Equipment used during this night work will include excavators, vacuum trucks, road saw, construction trucks, hand tools, compaction equipment, asphalt paver, roller, light vehicles, lighting towers and traffic control. The works are expected to generate high noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise associated with this work by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

During asphaltting night work residents may feel vibration from the compaction and asphaltting equipment, which may cause items in your home to rattle. If you have pictures on the wall that are not secured, you may wish to take them down as a precautionary measure. Please note vibration monitoring will be carried out and all equipment will operate within approved limits.
