



Tower Crane Disassembly - Parramatta Road Ventilation Facility

The remaining tower crane at the Parramatta Road Ventilation Facility (PRVF) is nearly ready to be decommissioned, dismantled and removed from the site. This work will be undertaken on Saturday, 15 December and Sunday, 16 December 2018.

A map of the work area is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

This work will involve:

- Using a mobile crane to dismantle the decommissioned tower crane;
- Disassembling the tower crane and loading parts onto trucks to be removed from site.

Equipment used will include a mobile crane, flatbed trucks, rattle guns and hand tools.

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this where possible, including turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, and directing noisy equipment away from residences.
