



ITS preparation work - Waratah Street, Haberfield

From Monday, 28 May 2018 work will commence to prepare for the installation of two overheight detectors, and a Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) on Waratah Street, Haberfield. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

Overheight detectors assist with preventing oversized vehicles from entering the tunnel. Please note that parking will be limited in the vicinity of the work site.

What we're doing

Work will involve:

- installing foundations and footings for the structures

Equipment used during the work will include a truck mounted piling rig, franna crane, rattle guns, trucks, concrete trucks, excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete saws, and hand tools.

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to minimise this by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Parking may be limited in the vicinity of the work site. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signage.
