



Franklyn Street Noise Wall Construction - Concord

From Sunday 13 January 2019, construction works will continue for the Franklyn Street noise wall. The work is expected to take one month from this date to complete, pending weather. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

What we're doing

The work will involve:

- Moving barriers
- Piling and piling pad construction
- Loading, hauling and compacting of material
- Installing permanent noise wall
- Painting
- Concreting works including: footpath, kerb and gutter
- Landscaping

Equipment used will include: sweeper, delivery trailer, light vehicles, smooth drum roller, bob cat, excavator, lighting tower, vacuum truck, chainsaws, bucket truck, elevated work platforms, semi-trailer, telehandler, franna crane, bogie truck, piling rig, excavator with hammer, vibrating compactor plate, concrete trucks and concrete saw.

How this affects you

There will be some noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to minimise this impact including by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noisy equipment away from residences where possible.
