



Legacy works – Arnott's Reserve and Allen Street Reserve, Homebush

From Wednesday, 8 May 2019, work will continue in the construction of an enhanced regional park at Arnott's Reserve and Allen Street Reserve in Homebush.

This work includes new pedestrian and cycle connections along Powells Creek, a playground area, barbecue facilities, formal new park entries, landscaping and open grass park areas for sitting, playing and picnicking.

The work is expected to take three months to complete, weather permitting. You will be notified as work progresses. A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf. This area highlighted will be fenced off from the public during construction, including Allen Street Reserve between Allen and Pomeroy Streets. The dog park fronting Allen Street will remain open to the public during this period of construction.

What we're doing

The work will involve:

- Geotechnical and services investigation
- Site remediation work
- Vegetation clearing
- Installation and removal of fencing
- Haul road construction
- Footpath construction
- Trenching for new services
- Installation of conduits
- Installation of light pole footings
- Playground construction works
- Installation of amenities and other park facilities
- Landscaping works

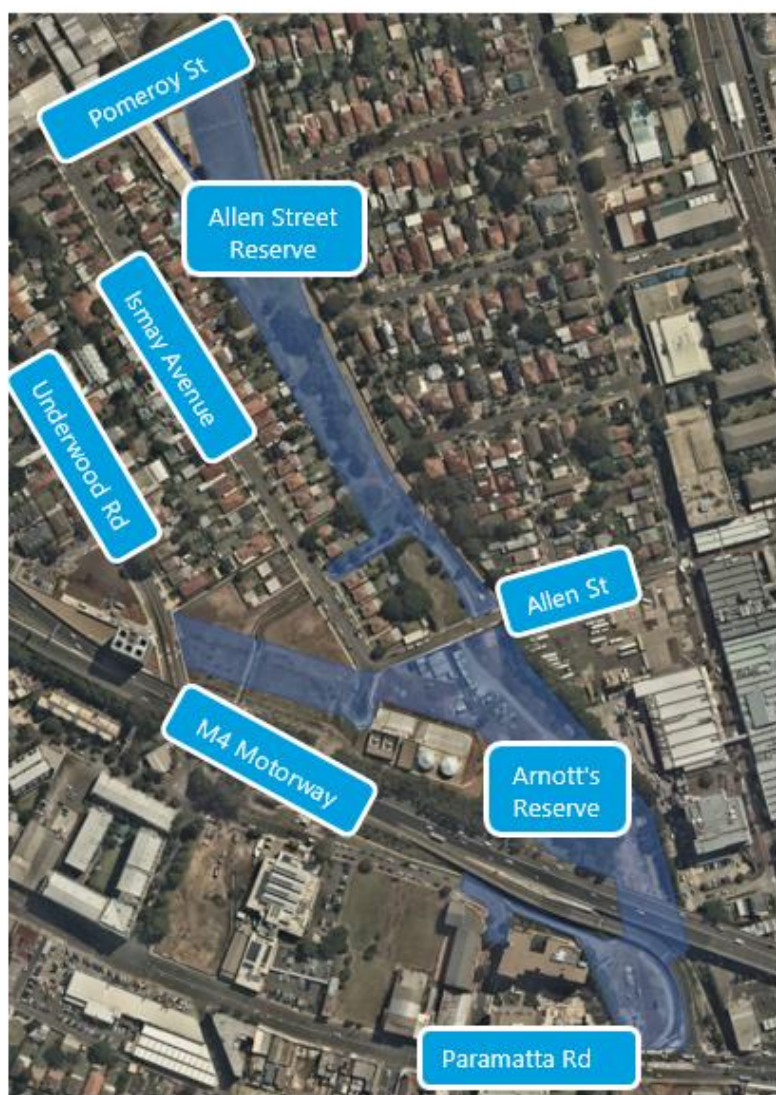
