



## Changed Traffic Conditions - Wattle Street, Haberfield

From Friday, 9 November 2018 work will commence to implement traffic changes along Wattle Street, Haberfield (between Parramatta Road and Waratah Street). These traffic changes are anticipated to occur over two nights, weather and ground conditions permitting. These changes are outlined below and shown on the map provided overleaf:

Night 1 (Friday, 9 November):

- traffic heading westbound on Wattle Street towards Parramatta Road will be split, vehicles going straight onto Frederick Street or turning left on Parramatta Road will need to exit into the far-left lane after Ramsay Street;
- the two through-lanes on Wattle Street after Ramsay Street will be for the right turn to Parramatta Road only.
- Night 2 (Saturday, 10 November):
- Wattle Street eastbound traffic will be split into two single carriageways from Martin Street to Waratah Street to create a temporary work zone in the middle.

### What we're doing

This work will involve:

- installing and relocating traffic barriers, signage, asphalt, line marking and directional markers;
- the reconfiguring of traffic signals.

Equipment used will include vacuum trucks, concrete saws, line marking equipment, cranes, millers, pavers, drum rollers, excavators, compactor plates, trucks, concrete trucks, hand tools and lighting equipment.

### How this affects you

The no right turn from Waratah Street onto Dobroyd Parade (City West Link) will continue to be in place during this package of work. Notification will be provided prior to the reopening of this movement.

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.
