



Construction Update - Haberfield

From Monday, 8 April 2019 work continues around the Wattle Street Interchange and the Parramatta Road Ventilation Facility (PRVF), Haberfield in anticipation of project completion in the upcoming months. A map showing the location of work is provided overleaf. Updates will continue to be provided to residents monthly.

What we're doing

Remaining work will involve:

- road and pavement work including line marking and asphaltting, and the remediation of remaining footpaths;
- removal temporary barriers and signage;
- removal of scaffolding, completion of perimeter walls, and mechanical fit out of the PRVF;
- landscaping and noise wall completion work, including painting.

Equipment used during the work will include but is not limited to excavators, vacuum trucks, concrete saws, cranes, trucks, compactors, road line markers, graders, asphalt laying plant, trucks, small tools, hand tools, and lighting equipment.

How this affects you

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers. Pedestrian access across the Wattle Street and Ramsay Street intersection is now open. Remaining footpaths will be reopened as work is completed.

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this including turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.
