



Changed traffic conditions - Parramatta Road Civil Site

From Monday, 19 November 2018 work will commence to implement traffic changes along Parramatta Road, between Bland Street and Dalhousie Street, weather permitting. This work will involve the reopening of Chandos Street (North), Haberfield at its intersection with Parramatta Road (eastbound).

These traffic changes are outlined below and shown on the map overleaf:

- moving traffic heading towards the city against the new eastbound northern kerb;
- temporarily reducing the eastbound lanes approaching Bland Street to 2 lanes;
- temporarily reducing the eastbound lanes approaching Dalhousie Street to 2 lanes;
- moving traffic heading towards Parramatta against the westbound southern kerb, allowing the work zone to extend towards Bland Street.

What we're doing

This work will involve:

- installing and relocating traffic barriers, signage, asphalt, line marking and directional markers;
- the reconfiguring of traffic signals.

Equipment used will include vacuum trucks, concrete saws, line marking installation and removal equipment, kerb machines, concrete agitators, cranes, millers, pavers, drum rollers, excavators, compactor plates, trucks, excavators, bobcats, hand tools and lighting equipment.

How this affects you

Traffic control and pedestrian management will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists, residents and workers. Please note that pedestrian access will stay as existing. If you travel along the route, please allow extra travel time and follow the signage and direction of traffic controllers.

The bus stop at Chandos Street has been permanently closed. Customers can use the Bland Street stop outside Muirs as an alternative. The bus stop at Dalhousie Street will remain temporarily closed. Customers can use the Saint David's Road bus stop as an alternative.

There will be some noise associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise this including using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and where possible, directing noisy equipment away from residences.

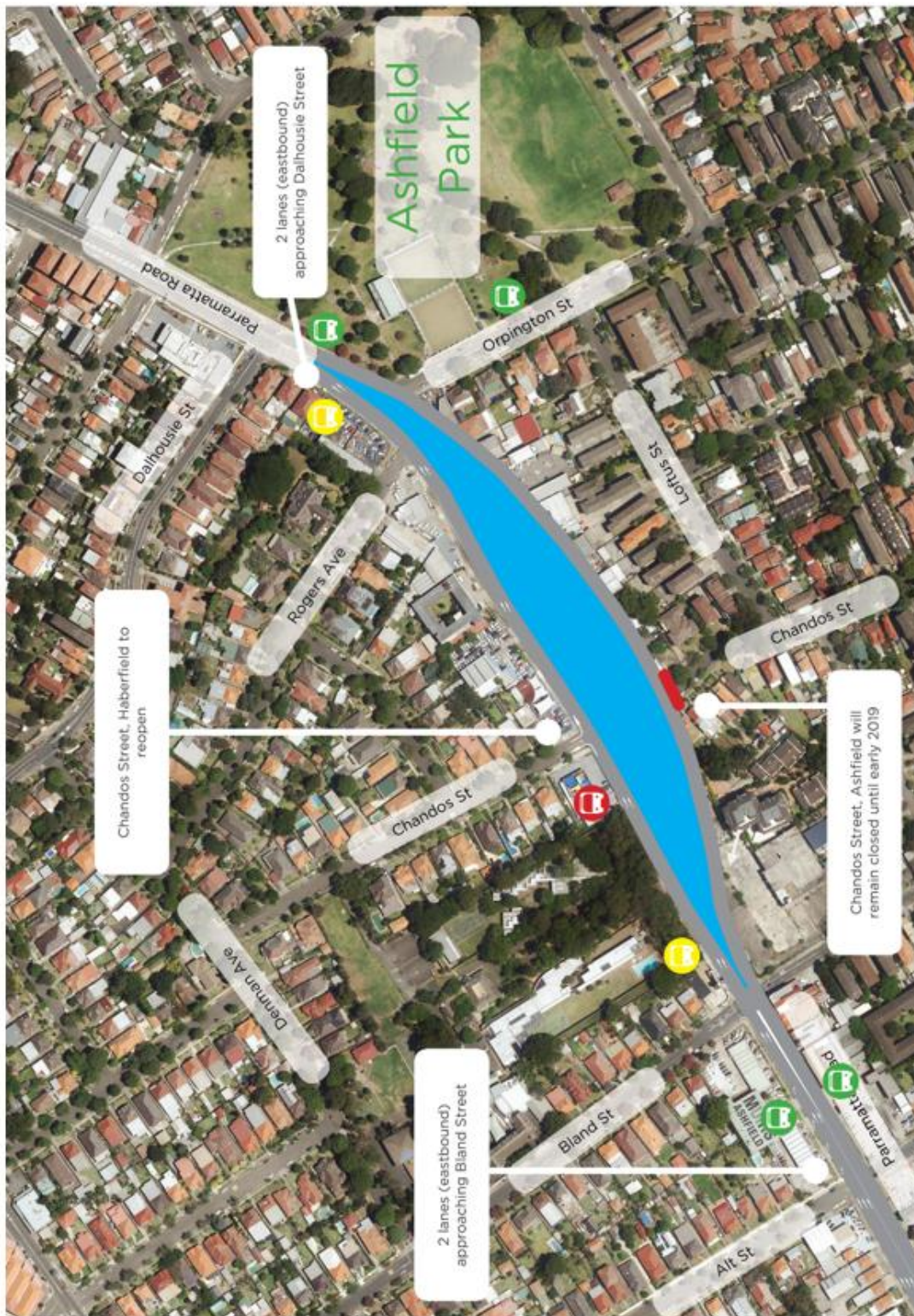
