



Night work and road closure on Hutchinson Street St Peters

A road closure will be in place on Hutchinson Street at the Campbell Street intersection to facilitate utility works, and to relocate and install concrete barriers. Due to safety and traffic approvals, this work must take place at night outside of peak traffic volume times.

What we're doing

Night work will take place on **Thursday 21 February from 7pm to 12am** to stand a wooden Ausgrid power pole in the western footpath on Hutchinson Street between Campbell Street and Lackey Street. A road closure will be in place on Hutchinson Street during this work.

In preparation for pole installation on Thursday 21 February from 7pm to 12am, excavation work will take place during day-time hours on Wednesday 20 February and Thursday 21 February from 7am to 6pm. There are no traffic changes associated with this preparation work; pedestrian access around the work area will be maintained under the direction of traffic control.

Work will also take place to install and relocate concrete barriers at the Hutchinson Street and Campbell Street intersection.

Traffic changes on Thursday 21 February from 7pm to 12am

- Road closure on Hutchinson Street at the Campbell Street intersection; no vehicle access into Hutchinson Street from Campbell Street
- One-way southbound traffic permitted on Hutchinson Street (reversed from one-way northbound)
- Two-way traffic permitted on a section of Applebee Street between May Street and Hutchinson Street under the direction of traffic control
- Access to Hutchinson Street via May Street and Applebee Street or via Princes Highway northbound, Short Street and Applebee Street
- Exit out of Hutchinson Street via Lackey Street and Applebee Street to Short Street and Princes Highway northbound or to May Street
- Pedestrian access on Hutchinson Street will be maintained under the direction of traffic control

Hutchinson Street, Applebee Street and Lackey Street residents, please take note of changed traffic conditions on Thursday 21 February from 7pm to 12am. Traffic control will be in place for the duration of the road closure to assist motorists, pedestrians and cyclists through the temporary traffic changes.

How this affects you

Parking restrictions will be in place on Hutchinson Street adjacent to the work area from 7pm on Tuesday 19 February to 12am on the morning of Friday 22 February to facilitate preparation work and pole installation.

Equipment used during night work on Thursday 21 February will include an elevated work platform, a mobile crane, compactor, hand tools, lighting towers and traffic control. This work is expected to generate some noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use. We will also direct noise and light generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

The site compounds on May Street and along the southern side of Campbell Street will be used intermittently throughout the work for storage of materials and vehicle parking.
