

Partial road closure – May Street, St Peters

Work is underway to install, relocate and upgrade stormwater drainage along Campbell Street. This will require confirming underground utility services in the area. A potholing program to identify existing underground services/utilities is planned along a portion of May Street. The information gathered will inform the design process for works in this area. Potholing requires excavating a small hole in the ground with high pressured water. Traffic changes and a partial road closure are necessary to facilitate this work.

Timing and work hours

Traffic changes will be in place on May Street **Saturday 16 September 2017** between **8am and 6pm** at the intersection of Campbell Street (west) and May Street in St Peters.

Traffic changes

Work is scheduled to take place on the **northern side of May Street**. During this time, only **southbound traffic** will be allowed on May Street. Entrance to May Street will be closed to traffic from Unwins Bridge Road, Campbell Street and Bedwin Road. May Street residences and businesses should enter via Princes Highway.

Traffic impacts will be in place during this work. Traffic control, signage, detours and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes. **The traffic changes are outlined in the map overleaf.**

Work activities

Equipment used during the work will include hand tools, potholing truck, vacuum trucks, road saws, traffic management and construction vehicles.

The work is expected to create minimal noise levels to nearby residents. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

- Scheduling noisy work to take place early in the day where possible
- Changing location of work each shift when possible
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible.

During the works, pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained where the footpath and road are impacted. Access to businesses will not be impacted throughout the work. Traffic control will be in place to manage and maintain traffic flow.


