



Work at Arinya Street, Kingsgrove

Utility investigation works (potholing) will be carried out along the shared pathway at the southern end of Arinya Street, Kingsgrove. It will be done during the week starting 25 June 2018.

Utilities Investigation

Potholing is a process where a small exploratory hole is dug along the proposed path of construction, to ensure there is no conflict with existing subsurface construction or feature that could interfere with the project.

A vacuum excavation technique is used so those features can be visually confirmed by our work crews.

How this affects you

An exclusion zone will be set-up to ensure pedestrian safety around the work area. Traffic control and signage will be in place to help pedestrians through the temporarily changed shared path.

At the completion of the day's work each exploratory hole will be filled with cold mix asphalt and be compacted to allow the shared path to reopen.

Some of this work will be noisy and noise modelling has been conducted for this work. We will use a vacuum truck, hand tools, concrete cutter and a plate compactor to complete the works.
