



Work on the M5 East, Kingsgrove to Beverly Hills

From 12 July westbound traffic will be shifted slightly to allow for pavement widening works on the M5 East between Kingsgrove Road and King Georges Road.

Realignment of M5 East westbound traffic

Permanent pavement widening works are required to facilitate construction of the New M5 tunnel portals and the bypass lanes. This work will be carried out from 9pm to 5am, 12 July to 19 July (weather permitting) to limit the impact on traffic and for the safety of works and motorists. These works will continue during the monthly M5 East maintenance shut down, scheduled from Sunday 22 to Wednesday 25 July 2018.

What we're doing

- Realignment of concrete barriers
- Removing existing line marking
- New line marking

Equipment used during the work will include line marking machine, line scrubbing machine, mobile crane, trucks, demolition saw, concrete saw, generator, lighting towers, road sweeper, construction vehicles and traffic management.

How this affects you

Westbound traffic will be shifted lightly left of the existing road alignment. This will not affect the traffic conditions. Signage will be in place to assist road users through the change.

The current speed limit of 80km/hour will remain unaffected.

Tolling Gantry Work

As part of the work to duplicate the New M5 corridor, new toll gantry infrastructure will be installed at the King Georges Road on and off ramps at Beverly Hills.

Tolls will not be charged until the New M5 opens in early 2020. For more information on tolling, visit WestConnex website.

Work for the tolling gantries will begin on the M5 East King Georges Road off at ramp Beverly Hills on 13 July 2018 (weather permitting).

What we're doing

Work will include the initial concrete pour for the permanent structure for the tolling gantries located on the westbound King Georges Road off ramp.

We will begin piling work to establish the placement of the tolling gantries and will need to remove trees and shrubs on the motorway side.

How this affects you

During these night works a lane closure on the Kings Georges Road westbound off-ramp may be required to ensure the safety of our workers and allow equipment access (see map overleaf). Signage will be in place to assist drivers through these changed conditions.

At the completion of the night works any lane closures will reopen to allow traffic flow.

Some of this work will be noisy.

The equipment used will be: Excavator, construction vehicles, piling rig, cranes, concrete pump, concrete truck, vacuum truck, hand tools, concrete cutter, generator lighting and a plate compactor.
