



Night work and road closure on Gardeners Road and Bourke Road/ Street, Mascot

As part of upgrading Gardeners Road and Bourke Road/ Street, ongoing night work is required to relocate and upgrade existing services into the new road alignment. **The next activity to occur is installing underground power and communication lines to facilitate the future removal of overhead power lines along Gardeners Road and Bourke Road within the Project boundary.** This work is required to be undertaken at night under traffic management for the safety of workers, motorists, pedestrians and cyclists as car volumes are lowest.

What we're doing

Work will be carried out intermittently **over the next month**, weather permitting, starting from **Wednesday 1 August until Friday 31 August** between the hours of **9pm and 5am**. Work will not occur in the same location for more than one night at a time.

The crew will be trenching along the southern verge of Gardeners Road to install new low voltage power conduits that will eventually facilitate removal of the overhead power lines. Removal of the power lines is expected to occur later in 2018.

A map showing the locations of the work is provided overleaf.

The work will involve trenching with an excavator, removing ground material, identifying the services and their depth in the ground, installing new conduits and then reinstating the earth.

Equipment used during the work will include lighting towers, hand tools, vacuum truck, excavator, bucket trucks, generators, traffic management and construction vehicles.

Traffic changes

A complete road closure on Gardeners Road and Bourke Street/ Road will be in place for the duration of each working night. Access to driveways located on Gardeners Road will be maintained for residents and businesses at all times. Residents and businesses will be required to provide their address to traffic control to be permitted through the closure to their property. A map showing the location of the road closure is provided overleaf.

Traffic control, signage, detours and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate through the changes. Traffic control on Gardeners Road will be setup away from residents where possible to minimise disruption

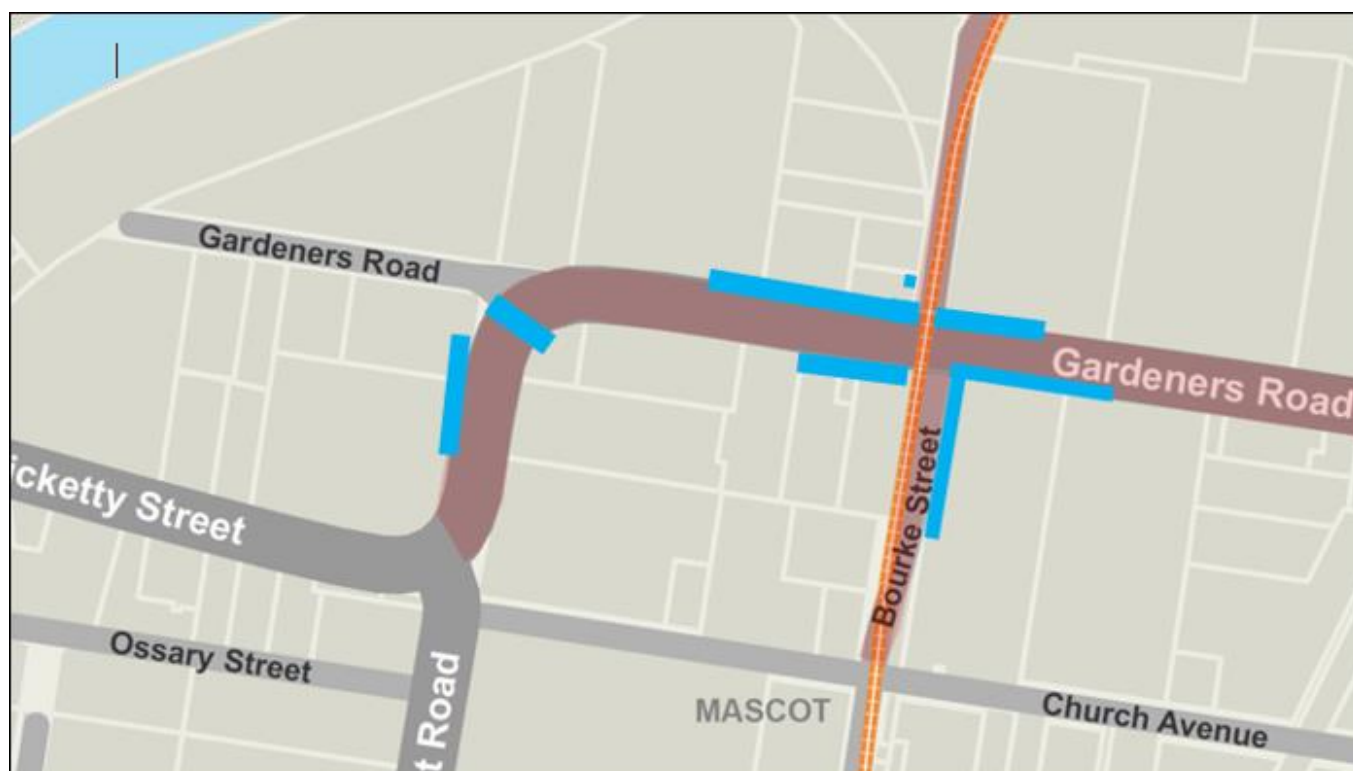


Minimising impact on residents

Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

- Scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible
- Installing noise blankets around the work site
- Changing the location of work each night
- Arranging traffic control so away from residents where possible
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible.
