



Night work and traffic changes on Euston Road, Campbell Road and Burrows Road, Alexandria

Optus night work to remove overhead cables is scheduled to take place on Euston Road, Campbell Road and Burrows Road at the intersection of Campbell Road on Monday 13 August.

The New M5 Project will be implementing changed traffic conditions in connection with this night work shift.

What we're doing

Monday 13 August, 7pm to 5am

Traffic control will be in place to assist with the safe movement of an elevating work platform (EWP) which will travel down Euston Road and along Campbell Road to Burrows Road to remove overhead cables.

Equipment used will include an elevating work platform (EWP), ladder, hand tools, construction vehicles and traffic management.

Traffic Changes

- Euston Road south of Sydney Park roundabout - local access for Euston Road businesses only
- Campbell Road - traffic will be maintained in both directions under a stop/slow traffic set up
- Burrows Road - traffic at the Campbell Road intersection will be maintained in all directions under a stop/slow traffic set up

Traffic control will be in place to direct local traffic, please expect delays.

How this affects you

There may be some noise impact to local residents during this work. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use.

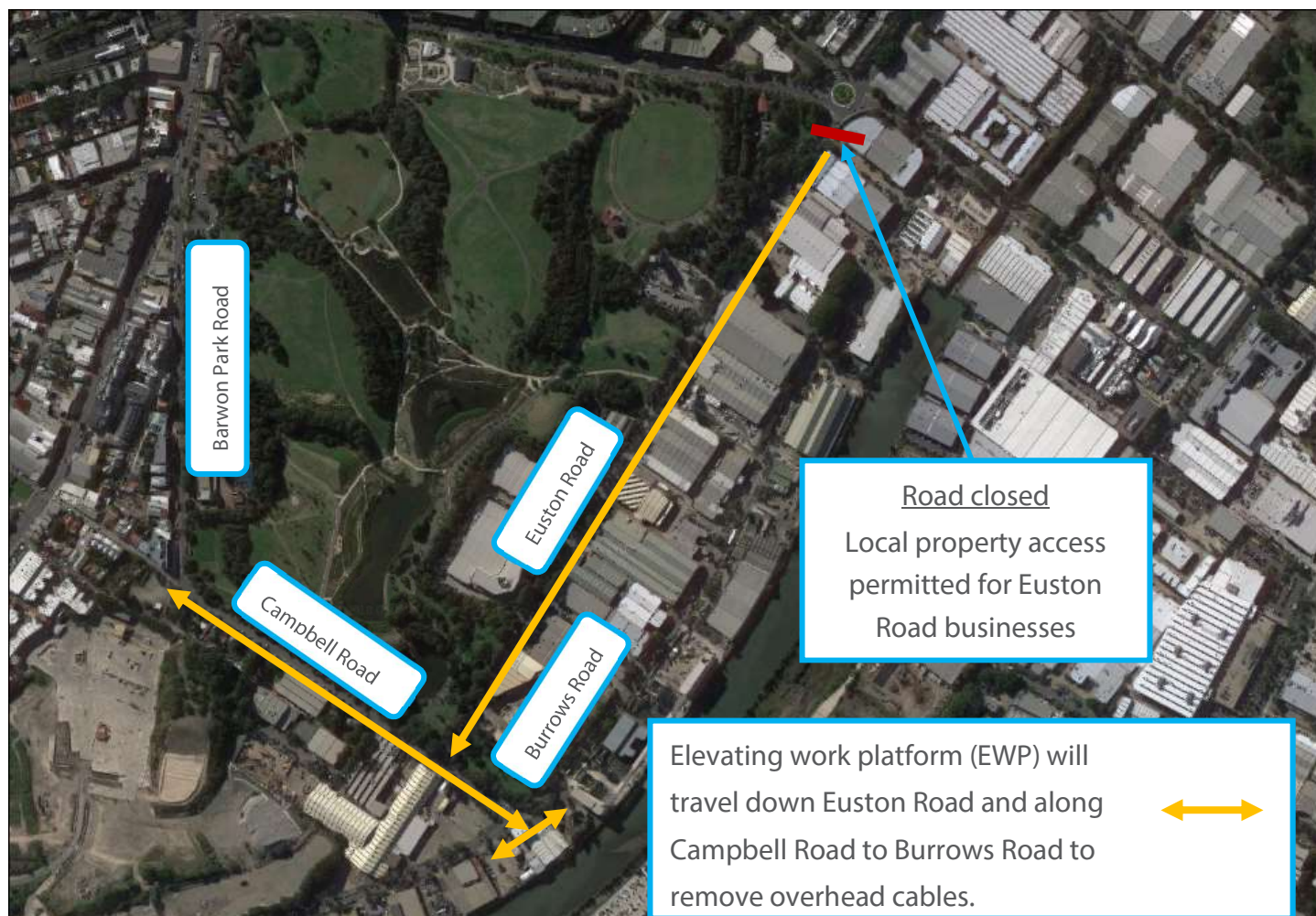
