



## Construction work is required for the Permanent Variable Message Sign on Botany Road, Rosebery

Construction work for the permanent electronic variable message sign (VMS) to be installed within the road reserve on Botany Road between Harcourt Parade and Gardeners Road, Rosebery is scheduled for Monday 12 November 2018 (weather permitting).

The location of the VMS has been selected to:

- minimise impacts to private property
- provide sufficient time for road users to read, understand and follow the message on the sign
- avoid conflict with existing road signs
- ensure safe access for maintenance crews
- comply with Roads and Maritime Services technical specifications

The VMS will support the efficient operation of the road network by providing real-time information about changes to road conditions due to accidents, bad weather, unforeseen traffic conditions, as well as planned events. This will enable road users to make informed decisions about their journeys.

### What we're doing

Construction will include:

- **Investigation work (finding services) - one night only Monday 12 November 2018**

### Further work activities below will be notified prior to work commencement.

- site set-up including installation of barriers and fencing around work site
- VMS footing installation including concrete pour
- trenching of the footpath and driveway to install the new VMS power and communications services
- piling work
- tree trimming only if required
- site reinstatement - reinstate footpath, driveway, remove concrete barriers and some of the fencing

Equipment used will include crane, excavator, saw cutter, compactor, hand tools, drill rig, trucks, lighting tower and construction vehicles to complete the works.

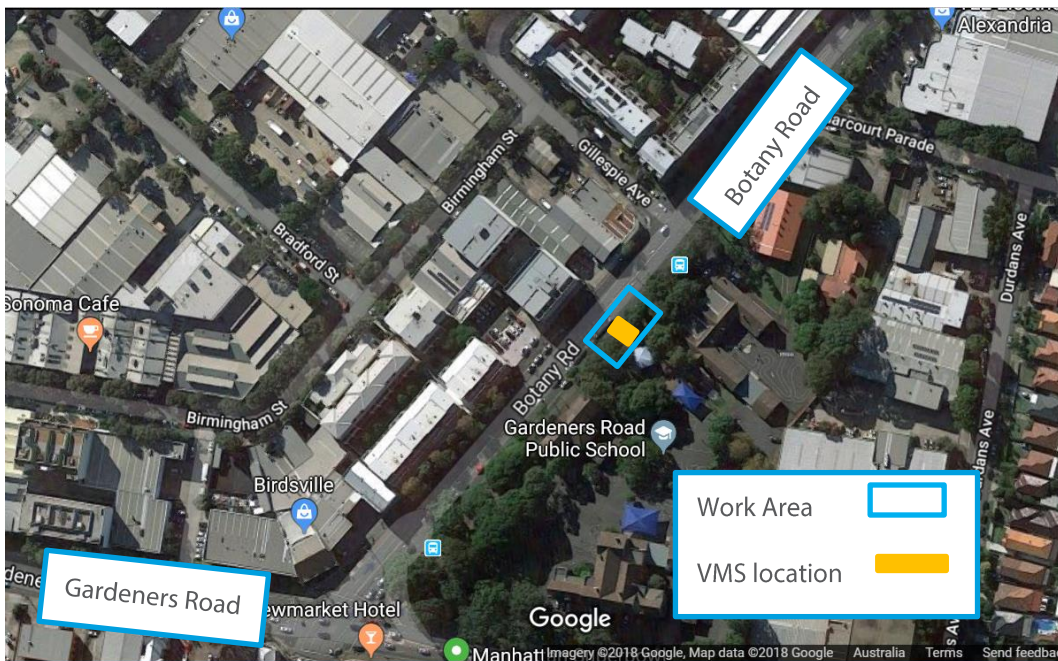
### How this affects you
