



Day/night work and traffic changes in St Peters between Monday 15 October and Saturday 20 October

Night work will take place to lay asphalt at the Princes Highway and Campbell Street intersection, and to install utility services on Unwins Bridge Road and Bedwin Road. Day-time utility work will be undertaken on Brown Street.

1) Asphalt night work at Princes Hwy and Campbell St intersection

Five nights of work are needed to asphalt and prepare the road surface at the Princes Highway and Campbell Street intersection. This work had been scheduled from 8 October to 10 October as detailed in notification No. 520 but was postponed due to wet weather. These works are being done to finalise the new road and footpath along the southern side of Campbell Street, from Crown Street and across Princes Highway to Brown Street.

- **Mon 15 Oct, Tues 16 Oct and Wed 17 Oct from 8pm to 5am (3 nights)**

Asphalting work will take place on the Princes Highway southbound lanes near the intersection of Campbell Street and on a section of road on Campbell Street (east).

Please note: Mon 22 Oct and Tues 23 Oct from 8pm to 5am (2 nights) have been tentatively scheduled for asphalting night work at the Princes Highway northbound lanes near the intersection of Campbell Street pending a review of forecast weather conditions. A notification will be distributed to local residents by Wed 17 Oct to confirm work dates.

Traffic changes Mon 15 Oct, Tues 16 Oct and Wed 17 Oct from 8pm to 5am

- Two-way traffic maintained on Princes Highway under the direction of traffic control
- Road closure on Campbell Street (east) between Princes Highway and Barwon Park Road; no access between Campbell Street (west) and Campbell Street (east)
- One-way traffic on Campbell Street (east) between Crown Street and Barwon Park Road; left turn only from Crown Street onto Campbell Street (east)
- Access between Victoria Street and Princes Highway maintained
- Parking restrictions will be in place in some areas on Princes Highway between Campbell Street and May Street to facilitate the necessary traffic set up from 7am Monday 15 October

Due to the necessary safety and traffic approvals required for lane closures on Princes Highway, asphalting work at the intersection must take place at night outside of peak traffic volume times.

2) Utility night work on Unwins Bridge Road and Bedwin Road

Night work will continue in various locations at the intersection of Unwins Bridge Road, Bedwin Road, May Street and Campbell Street to install new utility services underground. Please see map below to better explain the locations of this work.

- **Wednesday 17 October from 7pm to 5am**
- **Friday 19 October from 7pm to 9am**

Traffic changes on Wed 17 Oct from 7pm to 5am and Fri 19 Oct from 7pm to 9am: A stop/slow traffic set up will be in place at the intersection of Bedwin Road, Campbell Street, May Street and Unwins Bridge Road under the direction of traffic control. Traffic will be maintained in all directions, however please expect delays and follow the directions of traffic control.

3) Utility day work on Brown Street

Day work will be undertaken to transfer Ausgrid power cables from the existing power pole to the recently installed power pole on Brown Street approximately 50 metres from the Campbell Street intersection. Parking restrictions will be in place around the work area from 6pm on Wednesday 17 October.

- **Thursday 18 October from 7am to 6pm**

Traffic changes on Thurs 18 Oct from 7am to 6pm: Road closure on Brown Street at the intersection of Campbell Street. Access to Brown Street via Conway Place.

1 + 2) How night works affect you

Equipment used during these night works includes excavators, vacuum trucks, road saw, construction trucks, hand tools, compaction equipment, asphalt paver, roller, light vehicles, lighting towers and traffic control. The works are expected to generate high noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise associated with this work by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.

During asphaltting night work residents may feel vibration from the compaction and asphaltting equipment, which may cause items in your home to rattle. If you have pictures on the wall that are not secured, you may wish to take them down as a precautionary measure. Please note vibration monitoring will be carried out and all equipment will operate within approved limits.
