



Work to construct the Motorway Operations Complex buildings at Arncliffe

Night work is required to construct the Motorway Control Complex buildings at Arncliffe from 7 November 2018 to 30 April 2019 (weather permitting).

What we're doing

Structural building work in the exhaust shafts, concrete pours, construction of the Motorway Operations Complex, substation, water treatment plant, tidal storage basin and the ventilation supply shaft at Arncliffe. A map showing the location of the work area is provided overleaf.

This work will take place over the next four to five months between the hours of:

- Monday to Friday - 6pm to 7am
- Saturday and Sunday - 12pm to 8am

This construction work is required to be undertaken outside of standard construction hours for the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists.

Equipment used will include a concrete pump, concrete vibrator, trucks, construction vehicles, crane, excavator, hand tools and lighting towers.

How this affects you

There may be some impacts to residents during this work, including noisy machinery and lighting. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts, by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, using non-tonal beepers and facing lighting away from residential properties.
