



## Construction work to install a Permanent Variable Message Sign on Barwon Park Road near Princes Highway

Construction work for the permanent Variable Message Sign (VMS) is scheduled for Wednesday 14 November 2018 (weather permitting).

The location of the VMS has been selected to:

- minimise impacts to private property
- provide sufficient time for road users to read, understand and follow the message on the sign
- avoid conflict with existing road signs
- ensure safe access for maintenance crews
- comply with Roads and Maritime Services technical specifications.

The VMS will support the efficient operation of the road network by providing real-time information about changes to road conditions due to accidents, bad weather, unplanned traffic incidents and other unforeseen traffic conditions, as well as planned events. This will enable road users to make informed decisions about their journeys.

### What we're doing

Construction will include:

- **investigation work - one night Wednesday 14 November 2018**

### Further work activities below will be notified prior to work commencement.

- site set-up including barriers and fencing around work site
- tree removal and tree trimming
- levelling and removal of footpaths
- trenching of the footpath to install power and communications services
- footing installation including concrete pour
- piling work scheduled for early December 2018
- site reinstatement - repair footpath and verge, remove barriers and some of the fencing
- VMS sign installation - erecting of VMS pole and outreach arm

Construction work is required to be undertaken outside of standard construction hours for the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists. A map showing the location of the work area and VMS location is provided overleaf.

Equipment used will include crane, excavator, saw cutter, compactor, hand tools, drill rig, trucks, lighting tower and construction vehicles to complete the works.

### How this affects you

There will be some impacts to residents during the nightwork, including noisy machinery and the use of lighting. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts by not idling plant and equipment when not in use, non-tonal beepers on all plant and equipment, noise blankets and facing lighting towers away from any residential properties.

**There will be a closure at the top of Barwon Park Road including a one lane closure on the Princes Highway. (see map overleaf) Detour to access Barwon Park Road will be Princes Highway to Canal Road to Burrows Road and onto Campbell Road.**
