



Night/ weekend work and traffic changes on Burrows Road St Peters

Traffic changes will be in place on Burrows Road between Canal Road and Huntley Street, including at the Campbell Road intersection, to facilitate service investigation work, trenching and installation of underground power utilities and a new water main.

What we're doing

This work will involve digging trenches in the Burrows Road road pavement near the Campbell Road intersection. The road will be reinstated once work is completed.

- Thursday 6 December 7pm to 5am
- 7pm Friday 7 December to 6pm Saturday 8 December
- 7pm Friday 14 December to 5am Monday 17 December

Traffic changes will be in place during each night time and weekend shift, please see map overleaf to better explain these temporary changed traffic conditions.

Traffic Changes

Thursday 6 December 7pm to 5am and 7pm Friday 7 December to 6pm Saturday 8 December

- A stop /slow traffic set up will be in place on Burrows Road near the Campbell Road intersection
- Access will be maintained for vehicles travelling in both directions on Burrows Road, however, please expect some delays

7pm Friday 14 December to 5am Monday 17 December

- Full road closure on Burrows Road from Huntley Street to Campbell Road, local access only permitted
- No through traffic between Burrows Road north of Campbell Road and Burrows Road south of Campbell Road
- Access between Campbell Road and Burrows Road via Burrows Road south of the Campbell Road intersection only
- Access to Burrows Road (south) via Canal Road and Campbell Road only
- Local access to Burrows Road (north) via Huntley Street only

How this affects you

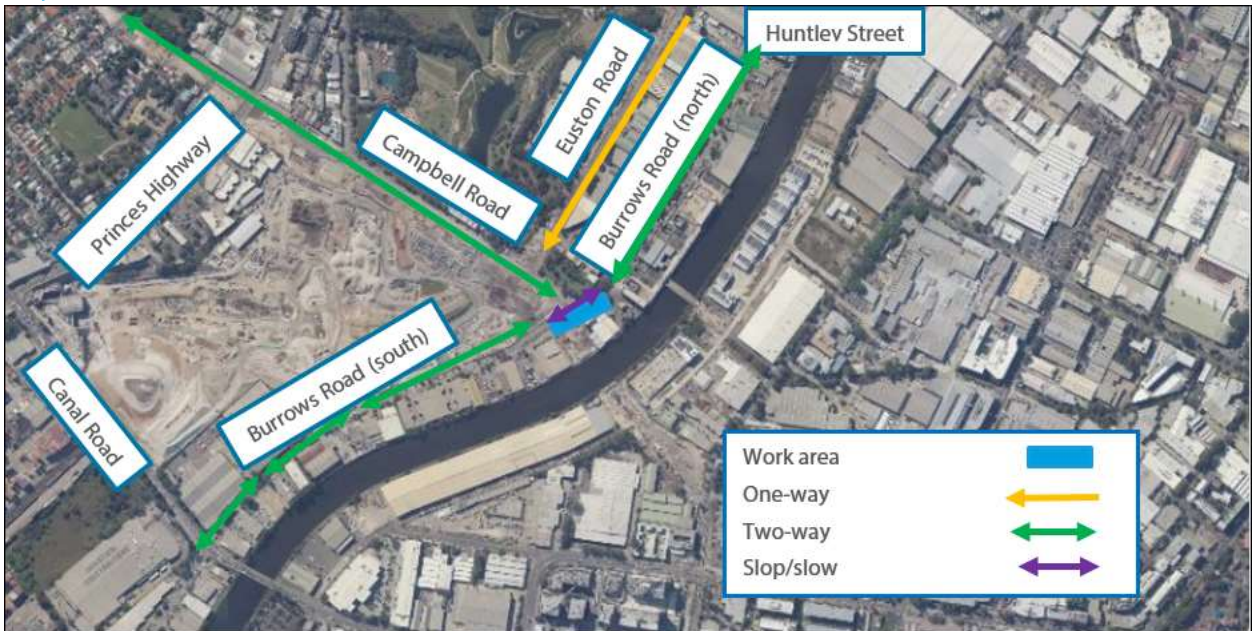
Equipment used during this work will include an excavator, vacuums trucks, road saw, rock breaker, hand tools, construction trucks, light vehicles, compaction equipment, lighting towers and traffic control.

This work is expected to generate high noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated by this work by turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use and directing noise and light generating equipment away from resident's properties where possible.

The site compounds on May Street and along the southern side of Campbell Street will be used intermittently throughout the work for storage of materials and vehicle parking.
