



Construction work to install a Permanent Variable Message Sign on Bunnerong Road, Daceyville

Construction work for the permanent Variable Message Sign (VMS) is scheduled for Monday 10 with Tuesday 11 December 2018 or Wednesday 12 December as a contingency night (weather permitting).

The location of the VMS has been selected to:

- minimise impacts to private property
- provide sufficient time for road users to read, understand and follow the message on the sign
- avoid conflict with existing road signs
- ensure safe access for maintenance crews
- comply with Roads and Maritime Services technical specifications

The VMS will support the efficient operation of the road network by providing real-time information about changes to road conditions due to accidents, bad weather, unplanned traffic incidents and other unforeseen traffic conditions, as well as planned events. This will enable road users to make informed decisions about their journeys.

What we're doing

Construction will include:

- site establishment including barriers and fencing around work site
- footing installation including concrete pour
- piling work

We will be working in the area again in early 2019 to complete the VMS; you will be notified prior to the work taking place.

Equipment used will include crane, excavator, compactor, hand tools, drill rig, trucks, lighting tower and construction vehicles to complete the works.
