



Night and weekend work on Euston Road and Maddox Street, Alexandria

New Ausgrid power conduits will be installed in two separate locations near the intersection of Euston Road and Maddox Street. This work is required to be done at night for the safety of pedestrians, workers and motorists. The work schedule is weather permitting.

What we're doing

This work will include excavating the current road, installing new power conduits and repairing the road. Work will occur in two work areas (please see map overleaf):

Work area 1:

- Monday 25 March, 8pm to 6am
- Wednesday 27 March, 8pm to 6am
- From 8pm Friday 29 March to 6pm Saturday 30 March

Work area 2:

- Monday 1 April, 8pm to 6am
- Wednesday 3 April, 8pm to 6am

Traffic changes

The following traffic conditions will apply during this work:

- Traffic controllers will guide motorists through the intersection of Maddox Street and Euston Road as traffic lights will not be operational during these works.
- The left turn onto Euston Road (south) from Maddox street will be unavailable during work.
- One westbound lane along Maddox street will be closed, however, westbound traffic will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian access around the intersection of Maddox Street and Euston Road will be maintained throughout this work.

Please drive carefully and follow the direction of traffic signs and controllers when travelling through this area.

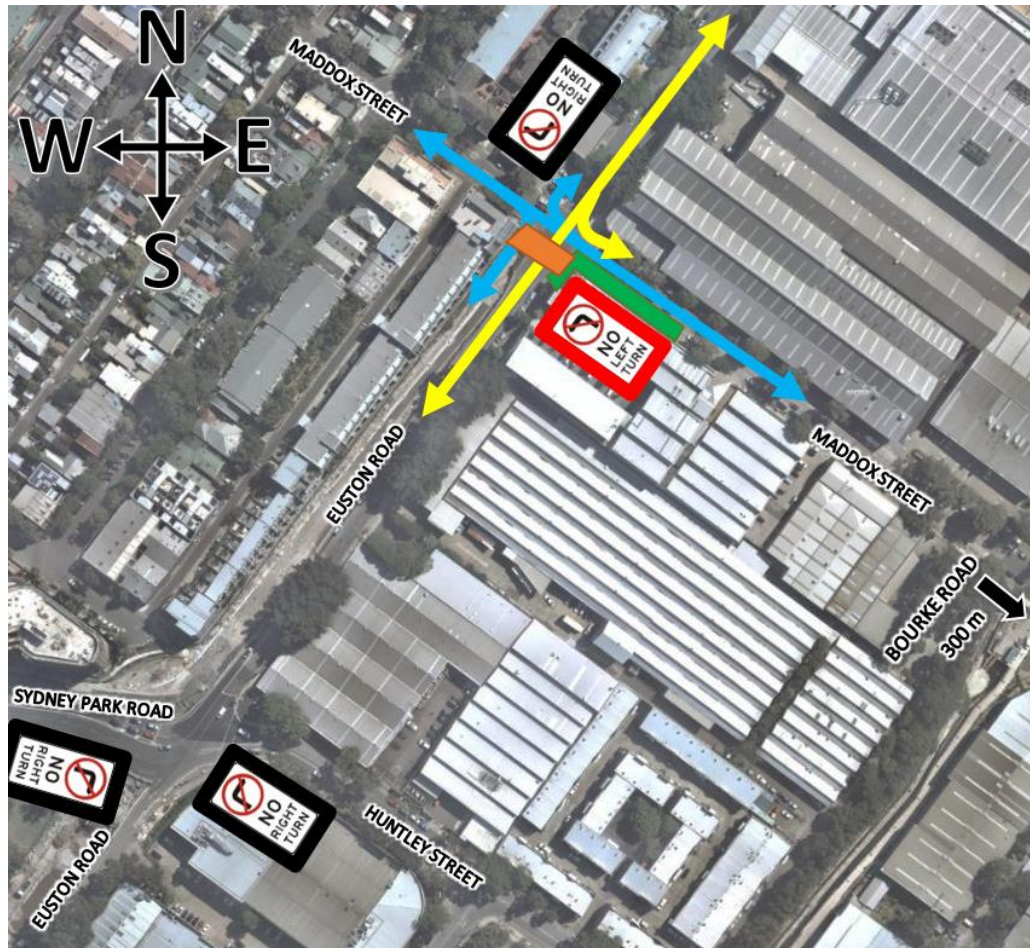


How this affects you







Equipment used during the night work will include lighting towers, concrete saw, excavator, asphalt roller, traffic management and construction vehicles. The work is expected to generate noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by scheduling any work that may have higher noise impacts to take place early in the night, where possible. Every effort will be made to turn off equipment and vehicles when not in use, and use non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery. We will direct noise generating equipment and lights away from properties where possible.
