



Night work on McEvoy Street, Alexandria

Night work is scheduled to install Intelligent Transport Services (ITS) infrastructure on Maddox Street. The ITS infrastructure will support new Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) to be installed at the intersection of McEvoy Street and Fountain Street to monitor traffic and provide updated traffic information to local Variable Messaging Signs (VMS) to be installed.

What we're doing

Night work will be carried out to locate and remove existing ITS services, and install new conduits. Work will include locating existing services with a scanner, excavating the current footpath and removing existing services, installing new power conduits and repairing the footpath. This work will be undertaken in two locations (shown in map overleaf).

Work area 1

Scanning work to locate existing conduits underground (not high noise work):

- Tuesday 26 March, 9pm to 5am
- Thursday 28 March, 9pm to 5am

Excavation and footpath repair work (high noise work):

- Tuesday 2 April, 9pm to 5am
- Thursday 4 April, 9pm to 5am

Work area 2

Scanning work to locate existing conduits underground (not high noise work):

- Tuesday 2 April, 9pm to 5am
- Thursday 4 April, 9pm to 5am

Excavation and footpath repair work (high noise work):

- Tuesday 9 April, 9pm to 5am
- Thursday 11 April, 9pm to 5am

Traffic changes

The traffic lights at the intersection of McEvoy Street and Fountain Street will not be operational during works in work area 2. Traffic at the intersection will be maintained in all directions under the direction of traffic

How this affects you

Equipment used during the night work will include lighting towers, concrete saw, excavator, asphalt roller, traffic management and construction vehicles. Excavation work is expected to generate noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by scheduling any work that may have higher noise impacts to take place early in the night, where possible. Every effort will be made to turn off equipment and vehicles when not in use, and use non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery. We will direct noise generating equipment and lights away from properties where possible.
