



## Night work on McEvoy Street, Alexandria

Further night work is scheduled throughout April for the installation of Intelligent Transport Services (ITS) infrastructure around the intersection of McEvoy Street and Fountain Street.

### What we're doing

As advised in community notification N.652 and N.664, new ITS infrastructure will support new Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) to be installed at the intersection of McEvoy Street and Fountain Street. This system will monitor traffic and provide updated traffic information to local Variable Messaging Signs (VMS), also to be installed.

Night work will be carried out on McEvoy Street and Fountain Street to remove existing ITS services, and install new conduits underground the road surface. Please see the location of this work on the map overleaf. Work will include excavating the current footpath and removing existing services, installing new ITS conduits and reinstating the footpath by 5am each morning. This work will be undertaken during the following shifts.

- Tues 30 April, 8pm to 5am
- Thurs 2 May, 8pm to 5am

### Traffic changes

The traffic lights at the intersection of McEvoy Street and Fountain Street will not be operational during work and will flash amber. Traffic at the intersection will be maintained in all directions under the direction of traffic control personnel. Please drive carefully and follow the direction of traffic control personnel on duty and traffic signage when travelling in this area during this work. Pedestrian traffic on McEvoy Street and Fountain Street will be maintained under traffic control.

### How this affects you

Equipment used during the night work will include lighting towers, concrete saw, excavator, rock breaker, jack hammer, construction trucks, road saw, vacuum truck, traffic management and construction vehicles. Excavation work is expected to generate noise. Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by scheduling any work that may have higher noise impacts to take place early in the night, where possible. Every effort will be made to turn off equipment and vehicles when not in use and use non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery. We will direct noise generating equipment and lights away from properties where possible.
