



Night work in Kingsgrove & Bexley North

Night work will be undertaken in sections of the road verge, on the M5 East between Bexley Road and King Georges Road, Beverly Hills to progress construction of the New M5 in Kingsgrove and Bexley North.

What we're doing

Work will be carried out over four nights during the existing M5 East maintenance shutdown period from Sunday 17 February to Wednesday 20 February 2019 (weather permitting). These works will be undertaken outside of normal construction hours for the safety of workers and motorists.

A map showing the location of the work is provided overleaf.

Activities for the February shutdown will include:

- Barrier movement on the westbound side of the M5 East
- Footpath construction at the King Georges Road on and off ramps
- Work on the median relating to stormwater earthworks
- Gantry work including footing excavation, concrete work, installation of cladding, conduit installation and backfilling, alignment and cable works at Kingsgrove Road and King Georges Road
- Tree removal and trimming
- North and south tunnel portal works including excavation work, piling, concreting and shotcreting
- Milling, resurfacing and asphaltting on road surface
- Service investigation
- Concrete pavement and footpath construction
- Work on the shared user path to facilitate the gantry installation at Bexley North
- Concrete saw cutting
- Signage removal and Installation of new signage
- CCTV inspection of stormwater drain
- Road sweeping
- Removal of the temporary Noise wall (shipping container)
- Trenching and conduit installation

Equipment used will include excavators, concrete cutters, truck mounted coring machine, cranes, trucks, elevated work platforms, vacuum trucks, road sweepers, concrete agitators, lighting towers, electric hand tools, chainsaws, wood chipper and compressors as well as other construction vehicles.

How this affects you

Some of this work will be noisy. Noise monitoring will be conducted for work undertaken outside of standard construction hours. Any dust generating activities will be watered down to minimise dust. Traffic control and signage will be in place to assist road users through these changed traffic conditions.
