



Night/weekend work and road closure on Bourke Street between Gardeners Road and Church Avenue, Mascot

As part of the New M5 Project, Bourke Street between Gardeners Road and Church Avenue will be widened. Work will take place over one weekend to build the new section of road pavement in this area. A temporary road closure and traffic detour will be in place.

The pavement construction work and road closure on Bourke Street will be ongoing from 8pm on Friday 1 February until 6am Monday 4 February and includes night work shifts on Friday 1 February, Saturday 2 February and Sunday 3 February (weather permitting). Please note, some preparation work will also occur on Tuesday 29 January from 8pm to 5am.

This work will be carried out at night and over the weekend outside of peak traffic times due to the necessary safety and traffic approvals required.

What we're doing

Work will be carried out to relocate and install concrete barriers, remove the existing road pavement and place new pavement and asphalt on the widened road surface.

Equipment used will include an excavator, concrete saw cutter, roller, plate compactor, asphalt paver, line marking removal and line marking machine, crane, vacuum trucks, construction trucks, hand tools, light vehicles, lighting towers and generators. Traffic controllers will be in place around the work area and on surrounding streets to direct pedestrians and motorists.

Traffic changes

A full road closure will be in place on Bourke Street between Gardeners Road and Church Avenue during the work from 8pm Friday 1 February to 6am Monday 4 February. A traffic detour will be in place via Kent Road and Church Avenue for vehicles travelling south from Bourke Road or west from Gardeners Road. Vehicles travelling north on Bourke Street will be detoured via Church Avenue eastbound. These detours are detailed on the map overleaf.

Following completion of work from 5am on Monday 4 February traffic will travel on the newly constructed section of road pavement. Please use caution following the changed traffic conditions.

Public transport changes

For the duration of this work, routes 307, 357, 418 and train replacement bus services in the area will be diverted and will miss some bus stops. Check signs at the stops or visit transportnsw.info for details of nearby alternatives.

How this affects you

Work will include asphalt milling. Asphalt milling will create heat and may have an associated odour. This asphalt milling method is the standard construction process for removing asphalt. All New M5 Project Safety and Environmental regulations will be adhered to during this work. A water truck will be onsite to help mitigate dust.

This work will be noisy. We will minimise noise and light spill by scheduling noisy work during the day when possible, installing noise blankets around the work area, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery and directing noise generating equipment and turn lights away from residents' properties where possible.
