



## Weekend work at Sydney Park Roundabout Euston Road, Alexandria

Work has commenced to transform the Sydney Park Roundabout into a signalised intersection to allow for better traffic flow in the area. The first stage has involved upgrading and moving all existing utilities into the new road alignment to prepare for road construction. In order to complete this stage, seven weekends of roadworks at Sydney Park roundabout are required by July. **This notification refers to the fourth and fifth weekend of work only.**

### What we're doing

Work will occur over two weekends, weather permitting:

- **Saturday 12 May** between 8am and 6pm. Work will be conducted during the daytime only on this weekend
- **Friday 18 May - Monday 21 May.** Continuous work between 9pm on Friday until 6am on Monday

The work includes:

- Installing high pressure gas and Intelligent Telecommunications Services (ITS) at various locations underneath Sydney Park Roundabout
- Installing new drainage down the centre of Sydney Park Road heading towards the roundabout

The activities will involve:

- Investigating the location of existing services
- Excavating a deep trench in the ground and installing new pipes, conduits and cables
- Reinstating the ground

### How this affects you

#### Traffic changes

The traffic conditions will change for both weekends of work. The first weekend on Saturday 12 May will include:

- Only one traffic movement around the roundabout permitted at a time. Motorists will be required to queue
- Closure of Huntley Street westbound between Burrows Road and Euston Road

The second weekend of work on Friday 18 May to Monday 21 May will include:

- The roundabout will operate as normal however capacity will be reduced to one lane. Drivers should expect some delays

During both weekends, a reduced 40 km/h speed limit will be in place around the roundabout and approaching streets. Delays are expected so drivers should avoid Sydney Park Road and instead use Canal Road, Ricketty Street, Burrows Road, and Bourke Road. A map showing the traffic impacts is shown below.

### Noise impacts

Equipment used for this work will include road saws, jack hammers, vacuum trucks, excavators, lighting towers, hand tools, generators, small crane, compactors, lights vehicles and traffic management.

This work is expected to generate noise. The Project will reduce noise generated at night by:

- Installing noise blankets around the work area
- Conducting noisier activities earlier in the night or daytime where possible
- Turning of vehicles when they are not in use
- Keeping conversations between workers and traffic control quiet

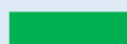
**New M5 work area
