Electrical work in Harber Street, Alexandria

Work will commence to install a new Ausgrid electrical conduit in the Harber Street car park. The installation is aimed at lowering all the overhead power. The power is expected to be commissioned in November 2017.

Timing of work

Work will commence from **Wednesday 30 August** and continue for approximately ten days, weather permitting. Work will be conducted during standard construction hours, **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and Saturday 8am to 1pm**. There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays.

Site arrangement

The construction site will be established and will require **temporary half closure of parking spaces** in Harber Street. Concrete barriers and fencing will be installed to separate and protect the work area. Construction vehicles will enter the site from Campbell Road.

On Tuesday 29 August a traffic controller will be located in the Harber Street car park from 7pm to place cones in the car park spaces adjacent to the terraces. Harber Street car park will be restricted to half the parking spaces from **7pm Tuesday 29 August 2017** till the completion of these works.

Harber St car park will be **fully closed** on **Tuesday 5 September 2017** for one day to facilitate trenching across the car park entrance.

Parking will continue to be available on the private road behind the terraces for the duration of works at this location. All Harber Street car park spaces will be reinstated once the work is completed. Alternate parking will be available on Campbell Road from Barwon Park Road to Harber Street and from Harber Street to Euston Road.

Scope of work

The work includes trench excavation, conduit installation, backfill and concrete /asphalt reinstatement. The work will take place in Harber Street car park and will be contained within an established construction site. Please see image overleaf for the location and arrangement of the work site.

Minimising community impact

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact of the construction activity on residents by:

- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Having traffic control assist vehicles and pedestrians across around the site
- Regular updates provided to resident body to provide progress of work and obtain feedback
- Directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible.
