

## Night work trenching on McEvoy Street Alexandria

Work to install a new 132kv electricity cable along Euston Road has progressed well, and now the project team is required to connect the new conduits into an electrical bay located at 141-167 McEvoy Street. Upon completion of this work, Ausgrid will continue installing the new cable along McEvoy Street to Waterloo.

### Timing of work

Four shifts of night work are required to complete the work: **Monday 16 October to Wednesday 18 October** between **9pm and 6am** and **Friday 20 October** between **7pm and 5am**. This work will be conducted at night when traffic volumes are lower for the safety for workers, motorists and pedestrians.

### Scope of work

The conduit installation involves potholing and digging a trench along the footpath or verge over a 100 metre section. The trenching will start at Harley Street and head north into the site established outside of the 147-161 apartments. Once the conduits are installed, the trenches will be backfilled and the verge and footpath will be reinstated. Please see image overleaf for the location of the work site.

### Impacts of work

The night work includes the installation of concrete barriers and signage along the road. Noise impact from the work is expected to be moderate.

As the trenching work will be done on McEvoy Street north bound, pedestrians should use the pedestrian path on the opposite side of the road.

### Equipment used

Equipment to be used during this work will include compactor, concrete corer, dump trucks, concrete truck, hand tools, trucks, light vehicles, lighting towers, and excavators.

### Minimising community impact

Every effort will be made to minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

- Scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible
- Eco barriers will be in place to reduce noise.

Construction vehicles will enter the site from McEvoy Street at the location of the driveway and will be assisted by traffic control.
