

Night work on Euston Road, Alexandria

Night work will be carried out to install Ausgrid conduits on Euston Road, Alexandria near the intersection of Campbell Road. The work location is shown on the map provided overleaf.

The work will involve trenching of the driveway, installation of Ausgrid conduits, backfill and reinstatement of the driveway.

Timing and work hours

Night work will take place on **Friday 2 February between 7pm and 5am**, weather permitting. This work will be conducted at night to facilitate day time driveway access for the adjacent business.

Traffic changes

No additional traffic changes are associated with this work. As the work involves trenching of the driveway pedestrians will receive assistance from traffic controllers to walk around the boundary of the work area.

Equipment used

An excavator, power tools, vacuum truck, lighting towers, bogie, tool truck, traffic control, and light vehicles will be used to complete the work.

Minimising community impact

The work is expected to create minimal noise impacts to nearby residents. Every effort will be made to minimise noise associated with this work by:

- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery during work
- directing noise generating equipment away from residential properties where possible

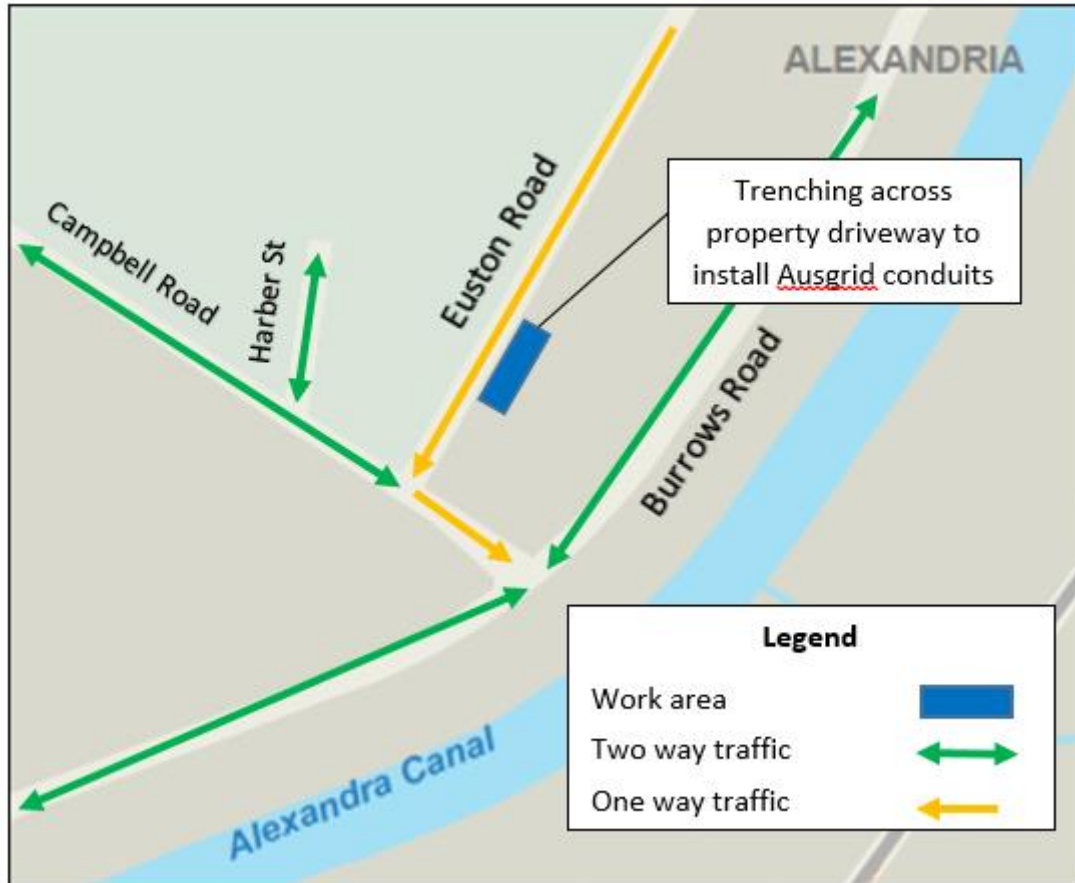
