



## Night work and road closure on Euston Road, Alexandria

Work is currently underway on Euston Road to install low voltage power cables that will eventually feed new street lighting. This work will take place **south of Sydney Park Roundabout**. This work is required to be undertaken at night under traffic management for the safety of workers, motorists, pedestrians and cyclists as car volumes are lowest.

### What we're doing

A crew will progressively trench from Munni Creek drain heading north towards Sydney Park Roundabout from **Friday 11 May**. Work will be undertaken **intermittently for three weeks**, weather permitting, and occur between the hours of **9pm and 5am each night**.

The work will involve breaking out a narrow trench, installing power conduits and backfilling the ground each shift. Saw cutting has already been completed in order to reduce noise.

The crew expect to complete approximately 12 metres of trenching per night and will start at the southern end and head north. At its closest point, the work site will still be approximately 80 metres from any residential properties.

### Traffic changes

**Euston Road south of Sydney Park Roundabout will be closed to the public each night.** Access for local businesses will be maintained. Residents living on Campbell Road are encouraged to use Princes Highway and Barwon Park Road for the duration of this work to avoid the closure and any potential delays.

A map showing the location of the work and the road closures, is provided overleaf.

Traffic control, signage, detours and reduced speed limits will be in place to assist local residents and road users to navigate around the closure.

## Minimising impact on residents

Equipment used during the work will include lighting towers, hand tools, vacuum truck, excavator, bucket trucks, generators, traffic management and construction vehicles.

The work is expected to create minimal noise for residents located north of the roundabout on Euston Road. Every effort will be made to further minimise noise and light spill associated with this work by:

- Scheduling noisy work to take place early in the night where possible
- Installing noise blankets around the work site
- Saw cutting the trench during the daytime
- Turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- Using non-tonal reversing beepers on all machinery
- Directing noise generating equipment and lights away from residential properties where possible.

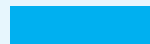
